Valley Mountain Bikers is writing to inform you that Hurricane Irene left extensive damage, in the form of fallen trees and limbs, to Nockamixon State Park, Salisbury Walking Purchase Park, and Trexler Nature Preserve. The fallen trees were so extensive in some areas that the existing trail was almost impossible to locate:





However, Valley Mountain Bikers and its members rose to the occasion and made extraordinary efforts this past week to clear the trails:







As a result, in just one week, nearly every mile of hiking and mountain biking trails in these parks have been cleared and are once again ready for outdoor recreation:





In addition, since VMB followed IMBA's sustainable trail design and construction guidelines, the trail surfaces themselves sustained very little damage, in spite of the tremendous amount of rain.
